



Child and Family Weekly Early Help Discussion Panel

November 2020



Our weekly Early Help locality panels are now focused on families with children aged 0 - 19.

This multi-agency forum, chaired by Children's Social Care, offers:

- A platform for discussion between multi-agency professionals about the provision of a thoroughly assessed and thoughtfully planned package of support for families, taking into account safeguarding needs and as a whole family approach
- The knowledge and skills of group members to ensure that services offered are appropriate to the needs identified
- Assurance that restorative practice is at the heart of decision making
- Support to frontline agencies to co-ordinate a plan (Early Help Assessment) where several agencies are involved with one family, and ensure intended outcomes are set and are achievable
- An assessment of need in relation to the Threshold Guidance to ensure that internal processes are followed where the case is identified to require a higher level of support
- The effective monitoring and tracking of Early Help through the use of Liquid Logic Early Help Module

The Panels take place, 9 – 10am, via Microsoft Teams, each focusing on a different Locality within Trafford:
